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Lexia English is the only program that is based on the learning science of language acquisition and proven to accelerate language acquisition. It draws on multiple disciplines to create powerful instructional models that are valuable for all students, but especially critical to ensure educational equity for Emergent Bilinguals.



To become fully bilingual, these students need a curriculum based in the study of how the brain learns to read, write, and speak. Lexia English’s embedded speech recognition technology provides students with immediate, guided, corrective feedback. The program also provides learners with opportunities for extensive, repetitive speaking and listening practice that spans the curriculum.

Lexia English’s curriculum was designed to align with proficiency standards for language instruction including WIDA, CA ELD, TX ELP. In addition, Lexia English meets “Promising” criteria for ESSA, as the program helped students across all demographics score higher on a state standardized test.

In that study, which examined the relationship between Lexia English usage and ELPAC test scores from the 2020–2021 school year, students who used Lexia English scored higher on their Overall, Oral, and Written scores than students who did not use Lexia English. Lexia English users consistently scored higher than non-Lexia English users across all grades examined, K–5.

Also, all Emergent Bilingual students in the study benefited from using Lexia English, while the largest positive differences on the overall performance were observed for students who spoke South Asian languages at home and those who spoke Spanish at home (+20 points).
