## Accelerate Oral Language Development With Speaking and Listening Practice

Oral language is the cornerstone of literacy for Emergent Bilingual students. Research shows that opportunities for speaking practice in the classroom lead to better long-term literacy outcomes. Emergent Bilinguals at every proficiency level need frequent opportunities to speak English to develop their oral language skills and achieve academic success.



**Lexia English provides Emergent Bilingual learners with extensive opportunities to practice their speaking, listening, and grammar skills**—building fluency and automaticity with the English language. Students speak up to 72% of the time in online, independent practice, in addition to face-to-face speaking and listening opportunities during teacher-led lessons.

In Lexia English, embedded speech recognition technology provides Emergent Bilinguals with immediate, guided, corrective feedback while listening for and accepting phoneme blends (diverse accents). Interactive academic conversations empower students to build linguistic confidence in an encouraging environment.





## What Is the Role of Speaking in Lexia English?

Lexia English allows for personalized interactions and conversations through purposeful repetition, offering students ample opportunities to practice in a safe and nonjudgmental environment. The language frames are introduced via the format: I do, We do, You do. This is done as a scaffold for introducing new grammar structures to the learner. The “I do” portion is done by the character who introduces the language frame. Purposeful repetition is provided as the learner goes on to the next step of saying the language frame along with the character (“We do”). Finally, the scaffolds are removed and the learner is completely responsible for engaging in conversations with the character on the screen (“You do”).

During every phase of the exchange, the learner receives instant corrective feedback based on the information the speech recognition engine is capturing. If the learner makes a mistake, they will be provided further instruction. If the learner is correct, they will be told exactly what they have done correctly and will move on to the next task. For example, the character on the screen might say, “Good job using *have they been* in the sentence.”


