

Lexia English Supports ELPAC Success

Results in a Southern California School District



STUDY: 679 students in grades K-6

Students who reached Expanding and Bridging bands in Lexia English Language Development™ averaged **an ELPAC score of 1,516.**



Correlations Matter

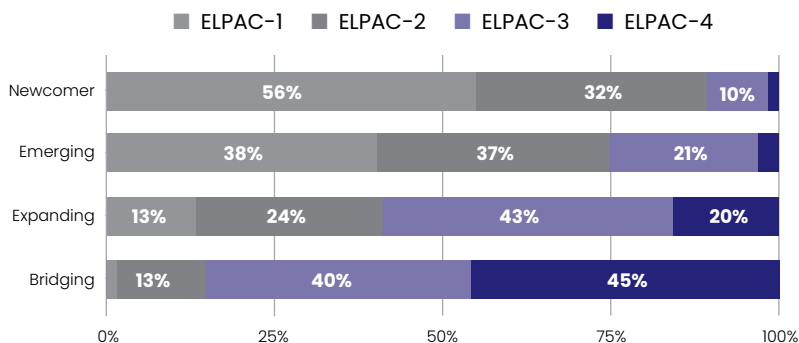
Across all grade levels (K-6), there were strong, positive, and statistically significant correlations (**overall .53**) between students' Lexia English end levels and their end-of-year ELPAC oral and written language scores. *(Correlations >.35 are considered strong.)*



Strong Alignment With ELPAC

Students in higher proficiency bands in Lexia English are more likely to score higher on the ELPAC.

Percent of Students by EOY ELPAC Overall Placement Level and EOY Lexia English Proficiency Band



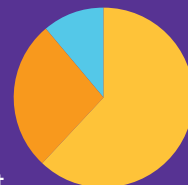

of students reaching Lexia English's Bridging proficiency band also placed in level 3 or 4 on ELPAC.



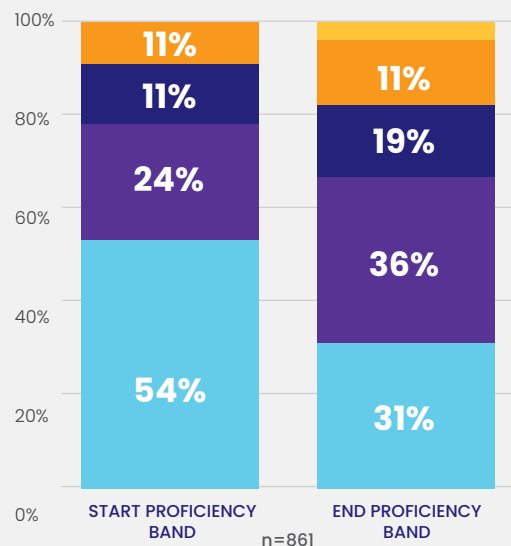
District Demographics at a Glance

Lexia English Program Growth

Across the district in general, **40%** of students who met usage guidelines in Lexia English **moved up at least one proficiency band** in the program.
