47% of students covered **three grade levels** of skills in one year

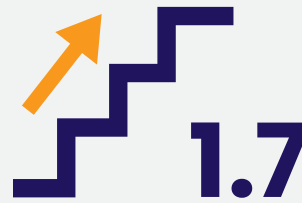


Less than 5% of students were working on foundational skills by end of year
