## The Summer Slide: A Critical Challenge

- **68% of multilingual learners in fourth grade** score below reading proficiency levels (NCES, 2017).
- Students can lose up to **30% of their school-year reading gains during summer break**.
- Multilingual students can face literacy setbacks during the summer if there is a gap in their learning.

## Lexia® Core5® Reading: Proven to Accelerate Summer Learning
