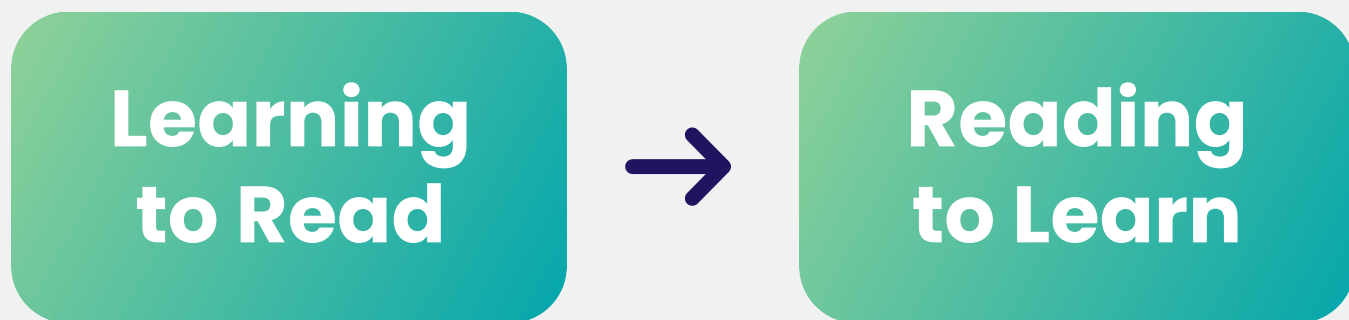

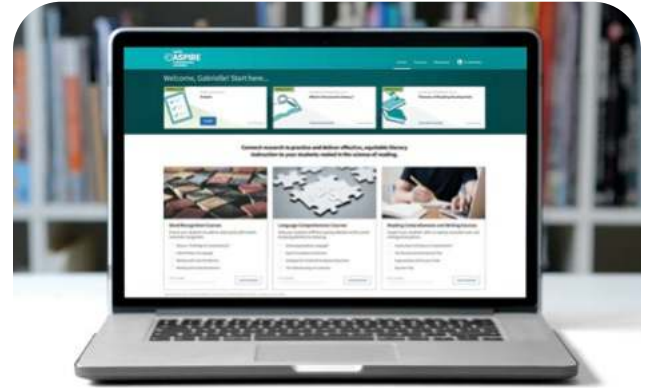

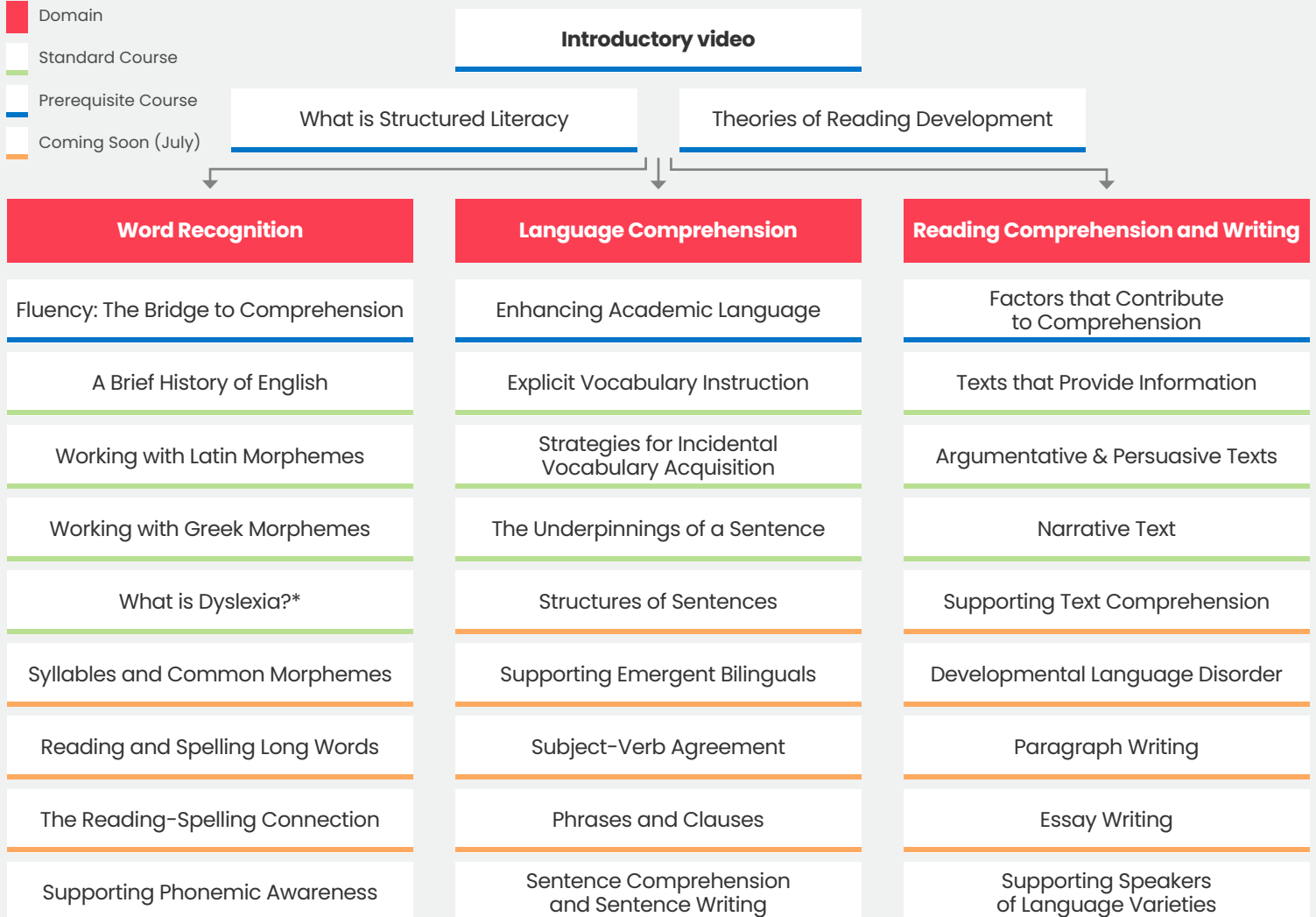
A program structure that’s educator-focused and informed by the science of reading

All participants establish a baseline for their knowledge and complete prerequisite courses. Then, they’re able to navigate Aspire’s 29 courses on demand at their own pace. Each course has its own “Check for Understanding,” which is scaffolded, to ensure educators fully understand the concepts they’ve learned. Completing all courses should take between 38 and 43 hours.
