The purpose of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER Fund) is to provide Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with emergency relief funds to address the impact that COVID-19 has had and continues to have on elementary and secondary schools.

Five ways you can justify using ESSER funds for Lexia to accelerate literacy development for your students include:
