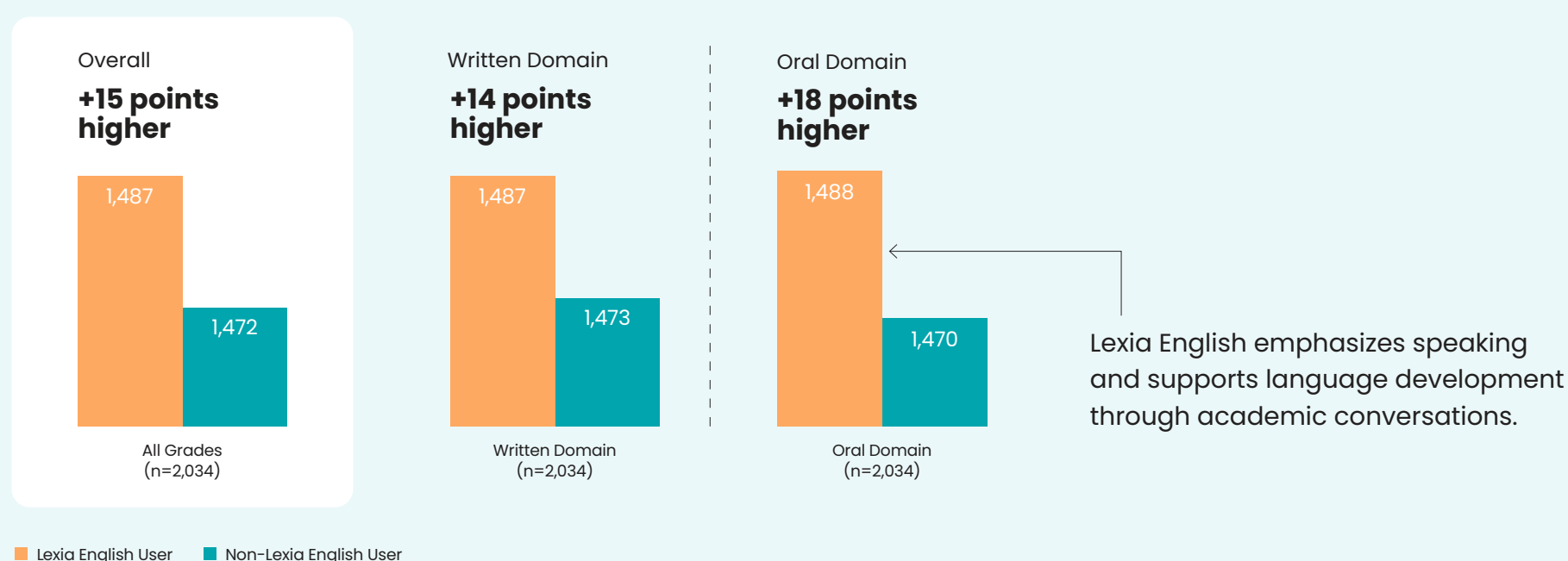

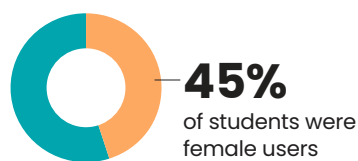
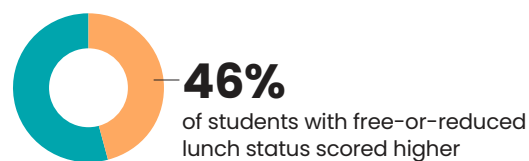
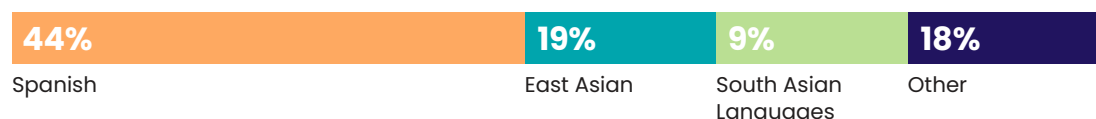
Higher scores with Lexia English use



Higher Scores for Every Student

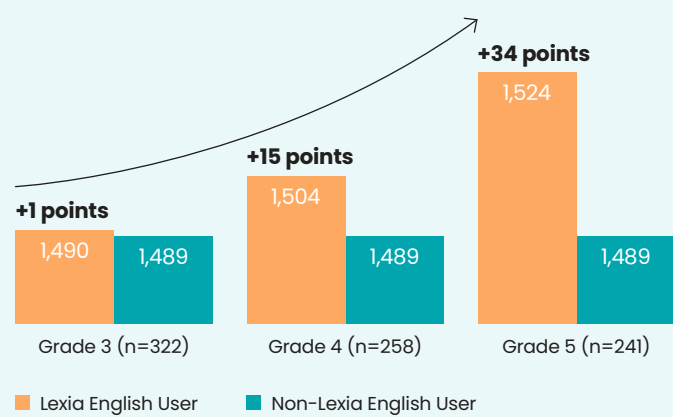
Students that used Lexia English scored higher than non-program users across all demographics, including gender, race, free-or-reduced lunch status, and home language.
